### **Inequalities during the coronavirus in Hungary**

#### **– Results of a representative survey –**

The representative survey is focusing on three main topics around inequalities during the corona crisis in Hungary:

1. labour market status;
2. care work;
3. access to digital tools.

The research was looking for answers to the following questions and many more: How did the corona epidemic affect social inequalities in Hungary? How did inequalities and injustices connected to gender and class evolve during the corona crisis? How did the restrictive measures affect different groups within the Hungarian society? How did employment and the financial situation of households shape inequalities? How did families deal with handling the new tasks resulting from the closure of schools, kindergartens and crèches? How did they divide the work duties connected to the new situation? How was this affected by the level of education, the financial situation, or the living place of the individuals? Did home-office help to alleviate the tensions between private life and work life? How did the time spent with caring for children or the elderly family members develop during the epidemic in different social groups, and for women and men?

The research was commissioned by the Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung's regional project „Gender equality in East-Central Europe” and was carried out in collaboration with Éva Fodor, Anikó Gregor, Júlia Koltai and Eszter Kováts. The event presenting the results will be moderated by Szilárd István Pap, deputy editor-in-chief of MÉRCE.

Following the discussion, the results will also be available in the form of a publication.
