## Nordic model in Hungary?



The Institute for Social Democracy (SZDI) and the Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung (FES), in cooperation with the Hungarian Trade Union Confederation MASZSZ are launching a series of programmes involving progressive political actors, trade union leaders and researchers. As the first part of the series, the Scandinavian practice will be presented and its lessons discussed. The so-called Cooperation Committee of the Nordic Labour Movement (SAMAK) is the committee for cooperation of the Nordic social democratic parties and the trade unions in Northern Europe.
