The next panel discussion of the 2023 “Perceptions and Reality” event series of the **Friedrich Ebert Stiftung Budapest** and **Új Egyenlőség** magazine will be held on

June 13, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Muzikum Klub (Kossuth Klub, Budapest, Múzeum u. 7, 1088), the topic of the event is *Anti- Jordan Peterson: debunking paleo-conservative morality, part II.*

Government party specifically refers to the Canadian psychologist and moral philosopher Jordan Peterson and his paleoconservative morality as moral guidance to be followed in the 21st century. In this two-part panel discussion, we will demonstrate that Peterson's ideas are identical to the repressive moral standards of the early 20th century, reframed for a new and young audience. In the first episode on May 9, Felícia and Zoltán presented the person of Jordan Peterson, the birth of the Peterson phenomenon, the ideology and values on which the Canadian psychologist's moral guidelines are based and which Peterson promotes at mass events and in his books. In today's panel discussion, these doctrines and norms will be further analyzed and the danger that humanity faces if this morality is accepted as a guide will be presented.
