Foreign Workers in Hungary -Study presentation and panel discussion-

In cooperation with the Friedrich Ebert Stiftung Budapest and the Periphery Public Policy and Research Centre, a <u>study entitled Foreign Workers in Hungary - Facts and Labour Market</u> <u>Challenges</u> has been completed.

In this study Krisztofer Bodor examines the situation and impact of third-country nationals working in Hungary on the labour market, with a special focus on the manufacturing sector.

In terms of methodology, the study draws on individually requested statistical data and interviews with experts from a variety of backgrounds.

The study puts labour migration in Hungary in context, reviews the regulatory environment, presents detailed data that is not yet available in a comprehensive way, and describes the most typical challenges migrant workers face. It also analyses the opportunities and difficulties of representing the interests of foreign workers and the impact on Hungarian employment relations.
